

## Lampung as Sustainable Development Model of Agro-industry: *Bio-Energy vs. Food Production in Indonesia*

On 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009, Yokohama National University (YNU) and the University of Lampung (UNILA) signed an agreement on academic and student exchanges. The main focus of collaboration centers on sustainable bio-energy production in Indonesia. YNU launched two integrated projects on environmental science: Global COE program "Global Eco-Risk Management from Asian Viewpoints" in 2007 and "Leadership Program in Sustainable Living with Environmental Risk" in 2009. These two programs focus on land use change and its impacts on ecosystems in Asian and African countries. YNU invites UNILA scientists to the Workshop to discuss environmental risks linked to bio-energy production in Indonesia and beyond. Our primary concern is how to balance between food security and bio-energy production in Asian countries.

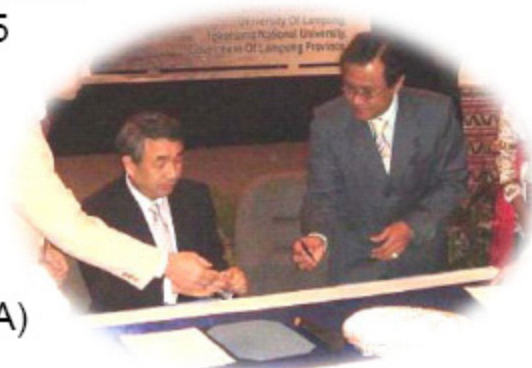
