

**Job Information: Professor as a Tenure-track Faculty Position**  
**Employer: Yokohama National University (YNU)**

Division of Intelligent Systems Engineering, Faculty of Engineering, Yokohama National University (YNU) invites applications for a tenure-track professor position in a field of physics. The followings are overview of the position, general qualifications and application procedures:

1. Job title: Professor
2. Job Description: Research area of a candidate should be high resolution spectroscopy of atoms and molecules in experimental physics. The successful candidate will be expected to participate in an undergraduate education in the Physics and Applied Physics Program of the Department of Mathematics, Physics, Electrical Engineering and Computer Science in the College of Engineering Science and a graduate education in the Specialization in Physics, Department of Physics, Electrical and Computer Engineering in the Graduate School of Engineering. A tenure track professor is expected to be involved in administrative duties as well as educational and research activities.
3. Start date: July 1st, 2014
4. Term of Employment: 5 years. The one who shows excellence in research and teaching, and proficiency in Japanese will be promoted to a position of tenured professor.
5. Each candidate must have a doctoral degree. The candidate whose mother tongue is not Japanese should have a working knowledge of Japanese in order to carry out education and research activities.
6. Complete applications received by January 17th, 2014 will be assured of consideration. A complete application should include the following documents:
  - A) Curriculum Vitae.
  - B) List of research achievement (Lists of Publications, invited talks, prizes, research grants etc.).
  - C) Up to 5 copies of major publications.
  - D) Summary of research achievements (up to 2 pages including figures).
  - E) Research plan at YNU (up to 2 pages including figures).
  - F) A short statement of your educational goals (up to 1 page).
  - G) Contact information and addresses of two references.Non-Japanese applicants may apply in English.
7. The complete application consisting of documents A)-G) should be recorded as a single PDF file in a CD or DVD. The printed documents and the CD or DVD should be enclosed in an envelope marked as "Application for a professor position at YNU (Physics)" in red and sent as a secured mail to the address given below.
