

Job Information: Associate Professor as a Tenure-track Faculty Position

Employer: Yokohama National University (YNU)

The Specialization in Ocean and Space Engineering within the Department of Systems Integration at the Graduate School of Engineering, Yokohama National University (YNU) is now inviting applications for an associate professor as a tenure-track faculty position in the field of Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering. The following is an overview of the position, required qualifications and application procedure.

1. Job title: Tenure-track Associate Professor
2. Job description: Candidates' area of research must be in the field of Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering, such as systems design, design/production systems, information systems, maritime logistics, numerical simulation, etc. A successful candidate will be expected to participate in undergraduate and graduate educational programs related to the above research field. Alongside educational and research activities, a tenure-track associate professor is also expected to take roles in administrative duties.
3. Start date: April 1st, 2018
4. Term of employment: Term of employment is 5 years. However, the tenure-track associate professor with significant achievements during the term will be promoted to a tenured position on the basis of evaluation.
5. Candidates must have a doctoral degree at April 1st, 2018. Candidates should have a working knowledge of Japanese and English in order to carry out education and research activities.
6. Completed applications must be received by August 10th, 2017, and will then be considered for eligibility. Those whose mother tongue is not Japanese may apply in English. Completed applications should include the following documents:
  - A) Curriculum vitae with photo
  - B) List of publications (reviewed journal papers, papers of international conferences, books, etc. (Impact Factor should be shown if possible.))
  - C) Up to 5 copies of work from major publications
  - D) List of research achievement (research grant, etc.)
  - E) Summary of research achievements and research plan at YNU (up to 2 pages)
  - F) A short statement of your motivation for teaching in YNU (up to 1 page)
  - G) Other notable achievement (if it exists)
  - H) Contact information and addresses of two references

7. A completed application consisting of the above documents A)-H) should be saved as PDF files and recorded on a CD or DVD. The printed documents and the CD or DVD should be enclosed in an envelope marked as “Application for a tenure-track faculty position at YNU” in red and sent by registered mail to the address below. It should be noticed that the application only by an e-mail is not accepted.
