



Health Insurance Health insurance is not included in the program fee. The purchase of travelers' health insurance prior to departure to Korea that is valid for the entire duration of travel is the responsibility of each participant and is strongly recommended.



In the event of cancellation, the participants must notify the Office of International Affairs(OIA) in writing.

- 1. For any cancellation after June 30, 2017, 20% of total program fee will be retained by OIA.
- 2. For any cancellation after the program starts, there will be no refund.
- 3. Participants will not be able to change the course(s) after June 30, 2017.



It is participant's own responsibility to check with their country and embassy if visa is required to enter Korea. Participants who need a visa will have to make their own arrangements in applying for the visa prior to their arrival here in Korea.
