

**Job Information: Assistant Professor or Associate Professor (5 years: can be shifted to the tenured track after 5 years).**

**Employer: Yokohama National University (YNU)**

**Location: Yokohama, Japan**

The Division of Physics, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Yokohama National University (YNU) invites applications for one tenure-track faculty position as an assistant professor or associate professor in a field of information science and engineering. The followings are the overview of the position, general qualifications and application procedures:

1. Job title: Assistant professor or associate professor
2. Start date: An earliest possible date (expected date)  
Assistant professor: [after April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016](#)  
Associate professor: [after Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016](#)  
Candidates should state which position they are particularly interested in.
3. Term of Employment: 5 years. The contract is NOT extendable, but opportunity for promotion (for the tenure position) would arise according to appointee's contribution for education and research at YNU.
4. Job Description: Candidates with scientific excellence are expected to have research or develop expertise in one or more of the following novel areas of information science and computer science.  
The fundamental and application fields of IT, IS or CS. The mathematical informatics, optimization, and massively parallel computation, Internet of Things (IoT), Machine to Machine (M2M), Cyber physical, biomedical, regulatory science based on IS and CS.
5. Candidates should hold a doctoral degree on the start date of the position. The candidate whose mother tongue is not Japanese should have a working knowledge of Japanese in order to carry out education and research activities.
6. The selection process does not exclude applicants on the basis of nationality, gender or

age. YNU welcomes the application of female and non-Japanese researchers.

7. Complete applications received by Jan. 8th, 2016, will be assured of consideration. A complete application should include the following documents:
  - A) Curriculum Vitae (including photo, academic record, job history, educational experience, research history, society activity, copy of diploma)
  - B) A research plan at YNU (1 pages) in terms of the field.
  - C) List of research achievement
  - D) Up to 5 representative publications.
  - E) Contact information and addresses of two references.

Those whose mother tongues are not Japanese may apply in English.

8. The complete application consisting of documents A)-E) should be sent as a single PDF file attachment by e-mail. The subject line of the e-mail should read as follows:

If your file is too large to send e-mail, please upload them to the appropriate web site with password and send the link and pass.
