
Oulu Online Collaboration Program -Taking a critical look at Finnish education-

Program Description

Since the Finnish "PISA miracle" in 2001, many international scholars have become interested to find out what we can learn from the Finnish education system. We invite you to join us online to explore the Finnish education model together and reflect on what we can learn from it by comparing it with the Japanese and other international education models.



Program Contents

The Finnish Education System

We will for example take a look at teacher education in Finland, educational policies and the importance of equity. Students will participate in a Japanese class in a Finnish high school to get first hand experiences of Finnish education.

Finnish Culture and Society

Any educatonal system is embedded into its countries' society and culture.

Therefore, we will take a closer look at Finnish culture and society and discuss how the core values of the Finnish welfare state, Finlands history and why Finland is the happiest country in the world.

Sustainable Development Goals

We use the SDGs to start a conversation around education and discuss the social, humanistic and moral purposes of education. The example of Finland will be used to showcase the transformative powers of education and to highlight the moral goals of education such as equitable learning outcomes..

After completing the program, participants receive 1 credit from Global PlusOne program.




WHO CAN JOIN?
