Prof. Yuasa Harumichi will represent the Institute of Information Security at the ceremony.



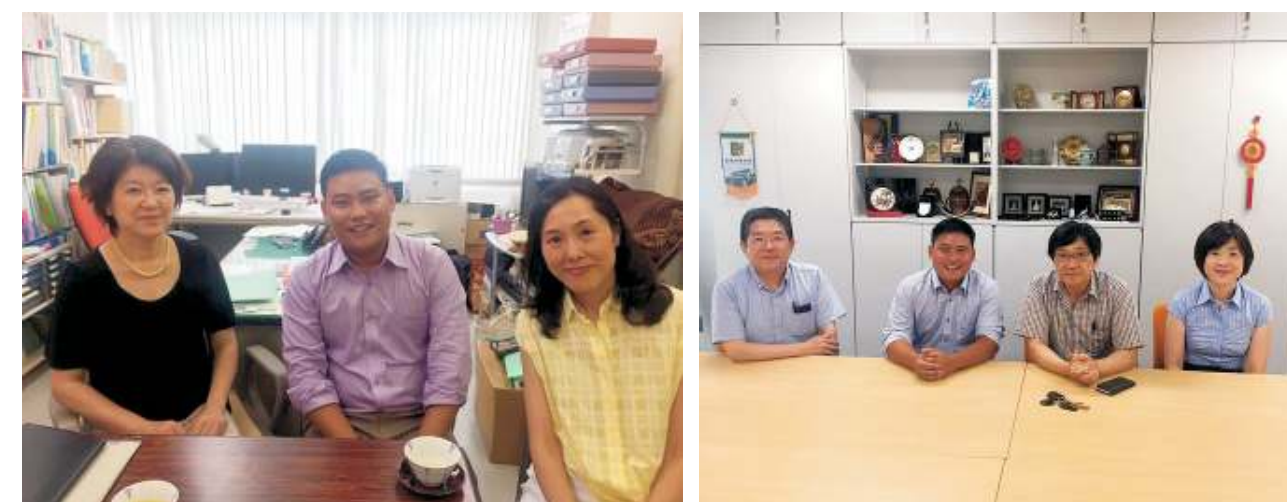
2017 Working Trip to Yokohama National University, Japan

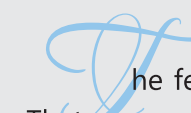


JAPANESE EDUCATION DAY

The Day had the participation of Jasso Organization, Okayama University Office, Vietnam-Japan University, Yokohama National University ...

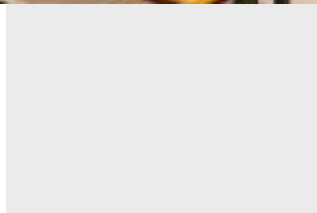
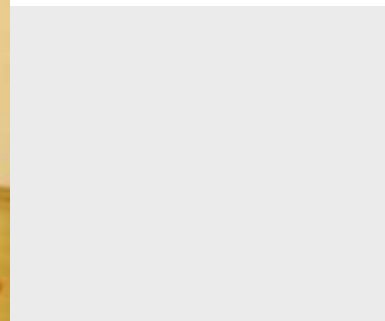

Jasso Foundation expressed the thankfulness the University of Danang for agreement and cooperation on the workshop organization.

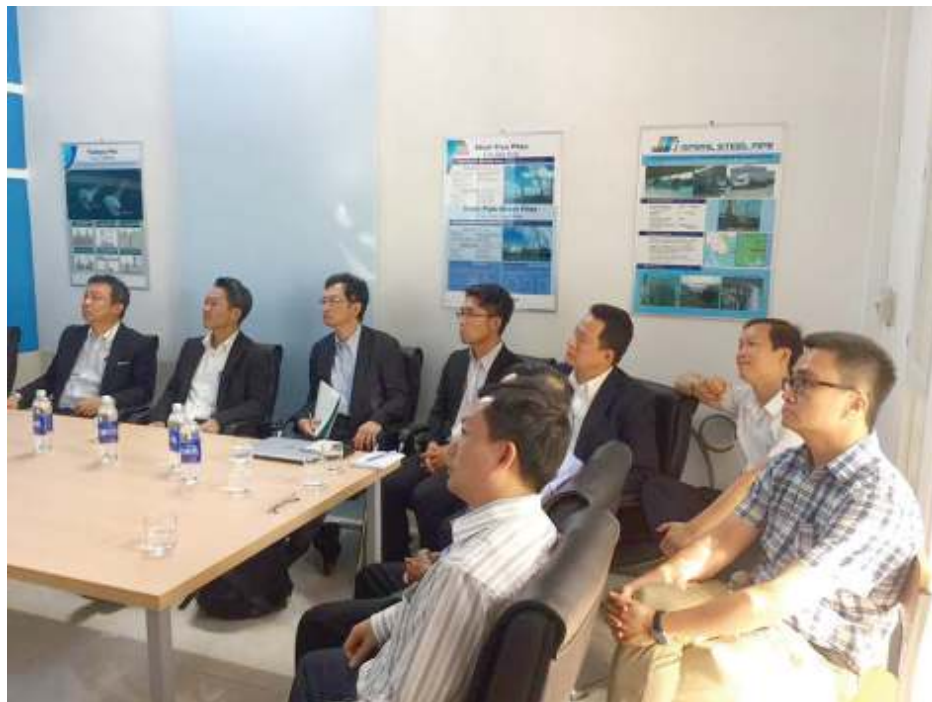

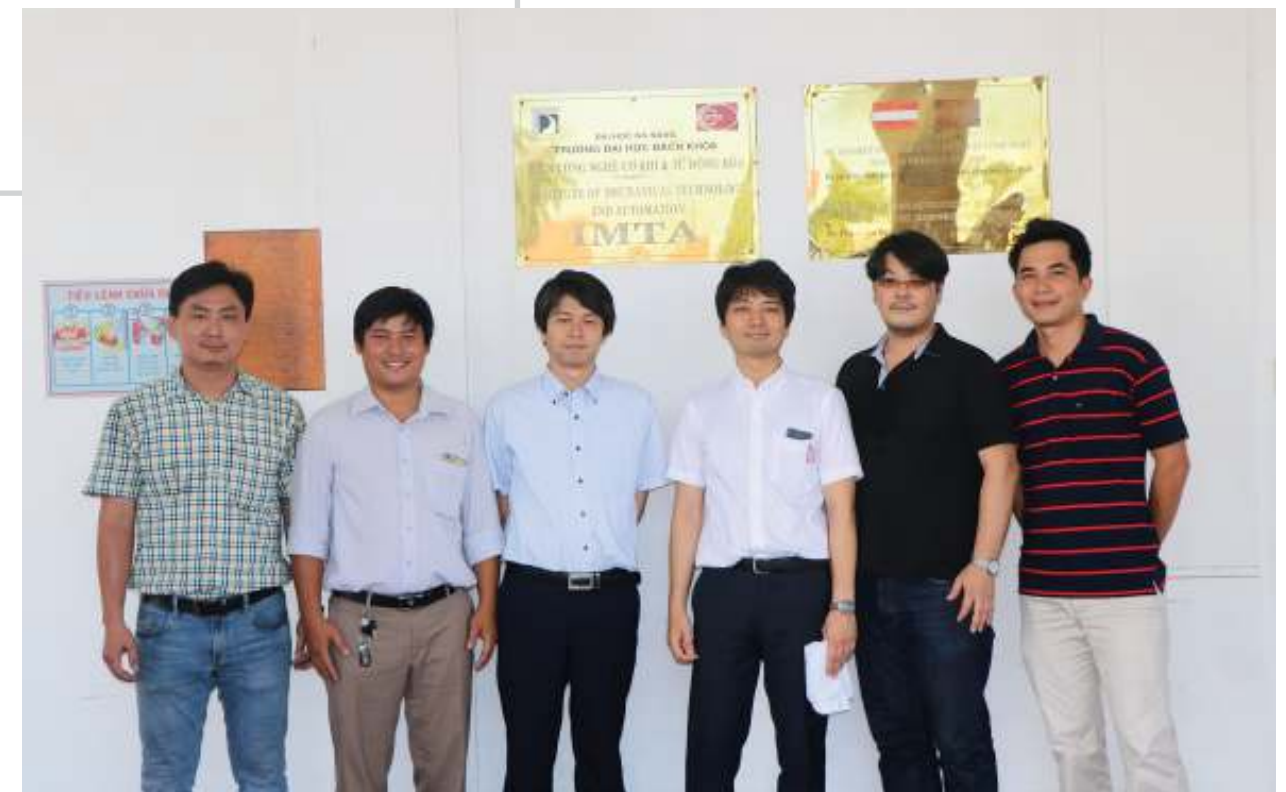

Seminar and Practical Training Course

Based on the last successful cooperation between the University of Da Nang and Yokohama National University, Japan (YNU); The approval of Director of the University of Danang; as well as the enthusiastic supports from the Board of Management of University of Science and Technology - The University of Danang (UD); Representative Office of YNU cooperated with 4 faculties: Faculties of Mechanical Engineering, Transportation Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering of University of Science and Technology UD to hold an intensive course on comprehensive technical experiment to students of the above- mentioned faculties.
